PART 1 GENERAL

1.01 INTENT OF SPECIFICATIONS

- A. These specifications establish standards and methods necessary for installation of sanitary sewers and appurtenances comprising extensions to Hilltown Township Water and Sewer Authority (HTWSA) Sanitary Sewer System.
- B. If any material and/or equipment installed is found not to be in accordance with these specifications, the developer or his contractor will correct, or remove and reinstall all unsatisfactory material and/or equipment to the satisfaction of HTWSA prior to, and for a period of one (1) year after, final acceptance by HTWSA.
- C. Approval drawings and related certifications for all material and equipment involved with sanitary sewer construction must be submitted to the Engineer for approval at least thirty (30) days prior to ordering that material or equipment. Any change orders involved with sanitary sewer construction must be approved by HTWSA prior to execution.

1.02 DEFINITIONS

- A. Whenever in these specifications the following terms, or pronouns in place of them are used, the intent and meaning shall be interpreted as follows:
 - 1. Owner/Developer – Person, partnership, or firm for whom and upon whose land construction is taken place.
 - 2. HTWSA - Hilltown Township Water and Sewer Authority, PO Box 365 Hilltown, PA 18927.
 - 3. Engineer – Castle Valley Consultants, Inc., 10 South Clinton Street, Doylestown, Pennsylvania 18901, or in the event said firm ceases to serve as Engineer for HTWSA, an engineering firm or professional engineer chosen by HTWSA.
 - 4. Observer or Resident Project Representative - The authorized representatives of HTWSA and/or Engineer assigned to make any or all necessary observation of work performed and materials furnished by the Contractor.
 - 5. Laboratory - The official testing laboratory of HTWSA, as may be selected by the Engineer and with the approval of, the Owner or HTWSA.
 - 6. Contractor - Party hired by the Owner/Developer to construct, acting directly or through his agents or employees. The Contractor, if a corporation foreign to the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, must be qualified to do business in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania pursuant to current laws.

7. Sub-contractor - An individual, firm or corporation, who contracts with a Contractor to perform part or all of the latter's contract.
8. Notice - The term "Notice," as used herein, shall mean and include written notice. Written notice shall be deemed to have been duly served when delivered to or at the last known address (business) of the person, firm or corporation for whom intended, or to his, their, or its duly authorized agent, representative or officer or when enclosed in a postage prepaid wrapper or envelope addressed to such person, firm or corporation at his, their or its last known address *and* deposited in a United States Mail box.
9. Plans or Drawings - All drawings, or reproductions of drawings, approved by HTWSA pertaining to construction within a particular subdivision.
10. Specifications - The directions, provisions and requirements contained herein, pertaining to methods and manner of performing work, or to quantities and qualities of materials to be furnished.
11. Work - The term "Work," as used herein, refers to all work at the project site and includes all labor, materials, supplies, equipment, and other facilities and things necessary or proper for or incidental to carrying out and completing terms of these Specifications. The term, "Work Performed" shall be construed to include material delivered to and suitably stored at the project site.
12. Provide - Shall mean "furnish and install" or "furnish labor and material required for installation of."
13. Indicated - Shall mean "indicated on the drawings."
